This agreement sets out what the school will provide and our expectations of parents and pupils.

Shared Aim

Our shared aim is the development of your child's abilities and the realisation of their full potential.

We seek to provide an attractive, safe and caring environment where children will want to learn and take pride in their work.

We will encourage them to be self-confident, self-reliant and self-disciplined helping them develop socially, to have a sense of moral awareness and to have regard for other people's feelings whatever their colour, race or creed.

Parents/Guardians will:

- Make sure my child arrives at school on time and is appropriately dressed and equipped (e.g. reading books, PE kits etc)
- Make sure my child attends regularly and provide a note/email of explanation if my child is absent
- Inform the school if my child is going to be absent
- Attend open evenings to discuss your child's progress
- Support the school's policies and guidelines
- Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems which might affect my child's work or behaviour
- Listen to my child read daily, sign their reading record and help learn their times tables
- Attend parent meetings with the teacher to discuss my child's achievements and progress
- Read all correspondence, including letters, text and emails that are sent from the school
- Support the school in teaching of safe and secure internet use at home

Pupils will:

- Always try to work to the best of their ability
- Learn and ask when I don't understand
- Come to school regularly and on time
- Be polite, kind and helpful to others
- Follow the school ethos and expectations
- Play their part in helping to create a caring community
- Tell somebody if there is something I am concerned or not happy about
- Use the internet safely as I have been taught in class

The School will:

- Provide an environment and atmosphere which is positive, challenging and supportive
- Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the daily life of the school
- Encourage parents to attend parent meetings, curriculum meetings and workshops
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum and a high standard of teaching
- Encourage children to do their best at all times and achieve their full potential as a valued member of the school community
- Encourage children to take care of others and their surroundings
- Develop, in each child, positive values and a caring attitude towards the school and wider community including the environment
- Strive to keep your child safe and happy
- Set regular and appropriate homework for every child
- Expect a high standard of behaviour
- Inform children and parents what teachers aim to teach the children during the academic year
- Inform you about what the teachers aim to teach the children each year
- Keep you informed of school activities through regular letters home, newsletters and notices about special events
- Deal with all complaints speedily and with sensitivity in line with legislation and current guidelines
- Celebrate children's achievements on a regular basis
