# How can we help to protect our children?

- Talk to our children about what they are doing online!
  - Spending as little as 10 minutes a week showing an interest in what they are looking at online can keep you informed in what they are doing, start the dialogue for open conversations and prevent something bad happening.
- Ensure their devices are in an open/high traffic area so you can see what they are doing at any point and you are close by if they encounter a problem.
- Be mindful about how you deal with any issues that arise.
  - Don't punish them for sharing something it will prevent them from coming to you in the future.

# Age restrictions

## They are there for a reason.



- Roblox -
  - under 13 can't use the chat function. If they want to chat use facetime so you know who they are speaking to.

- Snapchat
- 13
- WhatsApp
- 16



If they are using it younger than this please check

- you know who their friends are (Snapchat - use family centre, send your child a request, then you can see their contacts)
- friends are friends they have in real life, children you know
- your child can talk to you about issues they may encounter.

- Will give you lots of useful tips for keeping children safe while they use it, e.g.
- WhatsApp - How to prevent them from being added to a group without being asked
  - Settings, privacy, group settings, select from 3 - everyone, my contacts, select contacts (my contacts – advisable).
- Snapchat - How to stop their location being shared & how to turn off quick adds
  - Profile, settings, privacy controls, see my location – only me – ghost mode
  - See me in Quick Add – turn off

- Talk to your children, encourage them to speak to you before doing any, some are funny and silly but some are dangerous.

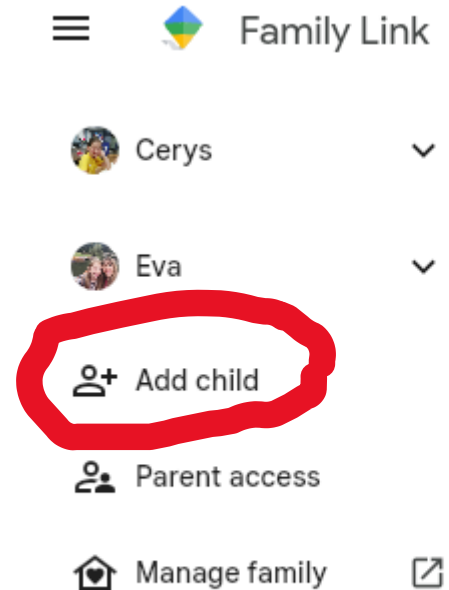
# Controls and restrictions



Good to set restrictions but doesn't replace the need for talking to your child.

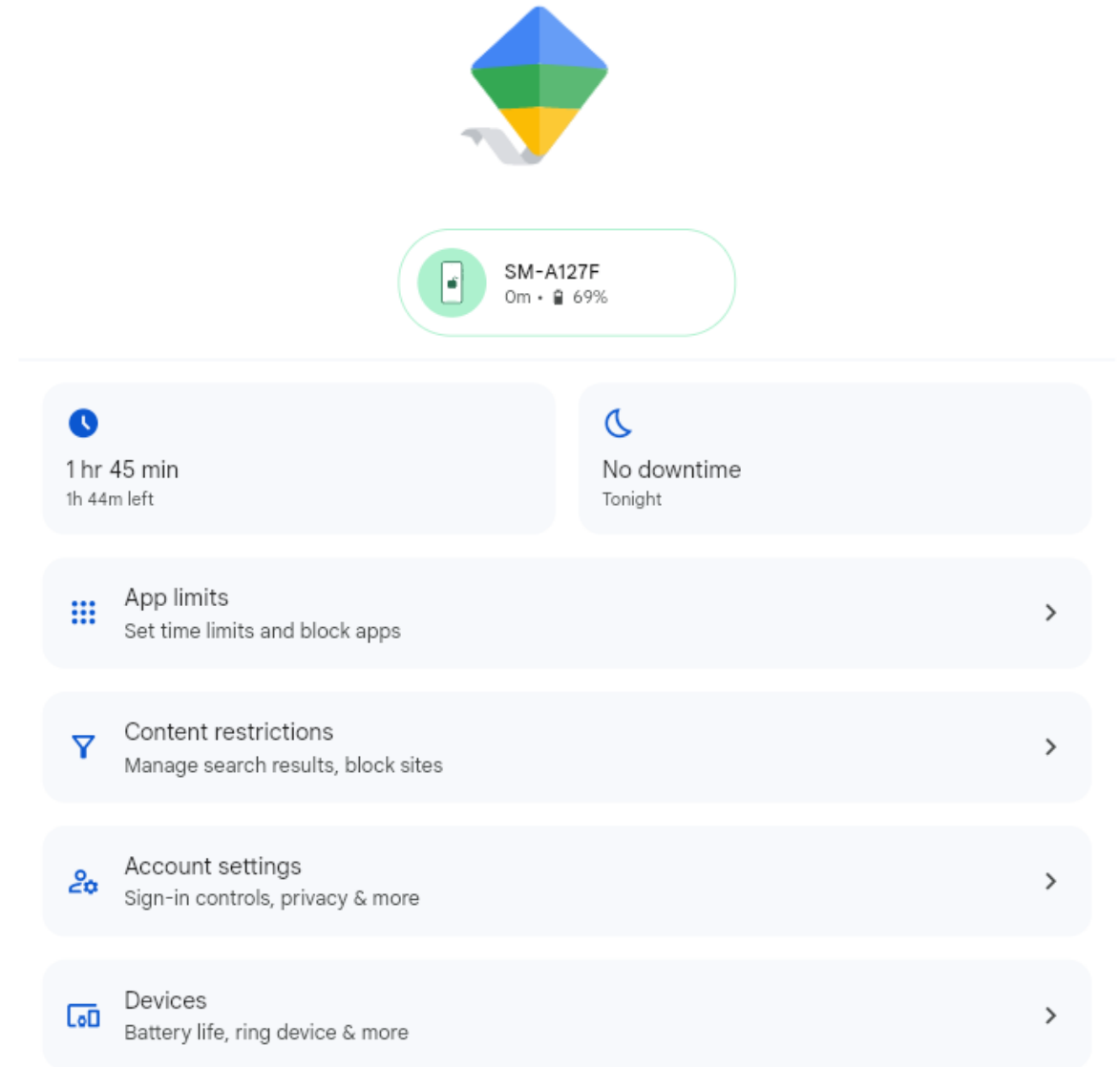
## Family Link

# Controls

- Today's limit
  - Allows you to set how much screen time you would like your child to have.
- Downtime
  - Allows you to set what time you would like your child's device to turn off
- App limits
  - Scroll down and tap on each app – allows you to block or set time limit





# Content restrictions

Allows you to go into apps and set age appropriate content, e.g.

- Google Play
- YouTube
  - (choose pre-school, younger, older)
- Google Chrome
  - Block explicit sites
- Google search
  - Turn on safe settings
  
- Remember no filter is fail safe!

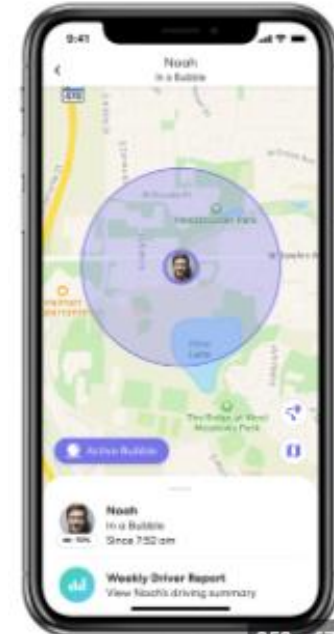
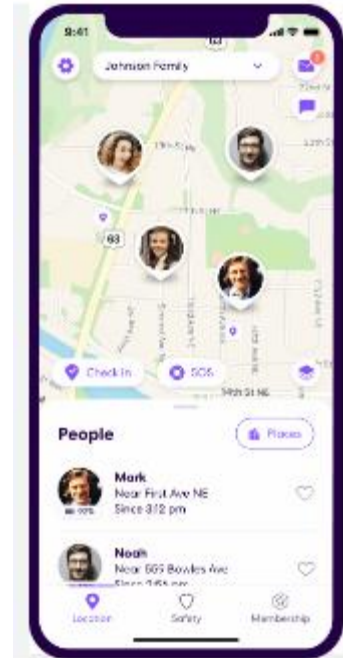

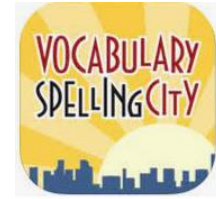
# EYFS, KS 1 & 2

  - improve phonic and communication skills by helping children improve their reading and writing

  - Experiment with virtual sculpture

  - Games to practise spelling, customize your own list using the website for your child to use in the app
